



# Official Rules

## The Race

- Races will be held in the following classes.
  - First Class: ages 10 – under
  - Second Class: ages 11 – 17
  - Third Class: ages 18 and older
  - \* if a class does not have at least 2 or more participants classes may be combined.
- Each class race will be a shotgun start that will include all racers of that class.
- Races will consist of starting at the top of Charlie Brown Hill and sledding all the way down.
- Sleds must cross the finish line in their sled to be deemed any type of winner.
- Winners will be determined by the official at the finish line. (Officials say is final no arguments!)

## The Sled

- Participants sled must be completely cardboard. Non cardboard sleds such as plastic, rubber, metal saucers are **PROHIBITED**.
- Participants should create their sled prior to showing up to the race on January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. **There will be no materials present at the race.**
- All sleds must be free of any sharp edges, pointy objects or any other object deemed to be dangerous. **(Sleds will be evaluated at time of registration. Sleds deemed unsafe will be disqualified before the start of race.)**

- Sleds must be created out of Corrugated cardboard.
- **Sleds made of materials such as listed below are Prohibited.**
  - **Corrugated Plastics, other corrugated materials: such as carpet tubes, or cardboard that is bonded to other materials such as epoxy to enhance the sleds productivity.**
  - **Tar-based substances: epoxy glue, fiberglass resin, two-part varnishes, or any other two-part substances.**
  - **Screws or any other sort of mechanical fasteners, nails, staples, any other means of holding the participants sled together that may be sharp or dangerous to the racer or other participants.**
  - **If there are any doubts DON'T USE IT.**
- **Sleds can only be taped at the seams of the sled and not the whole sled.**
  - **Sleds that are wrapped in plastic tape, shrink wrap, or any other material that will enhance the sleds performance is prohibited and will be suspended of the race.**

## **The Day of the Race**

- Participants are encouraged to have a theme for their sled, this can include costumes and decorated sleds.
- Registration will begin at 11:00 am at the Charlie Brown Sledding hill. (Participants are encouraged to park on the South Side of the baseball complex for convenience to get to the hill.)
- The First-Class race will start at 11:30 am with each race happening after the completion of the prior race. Racers are encouraged to show up by the start of the first race to be sure they don't miss their race.
- Awards will be presented at the completion of the three races.
