

Valley City Parks and Recreation Pool Guidelines

General Information

- VCPR will continue to follow state and local guidelines
- Increase in signage
 - o Having enter and exit doors (when possible)
 - o Encouraging social distancing
 - o The importance of hand washing
- Encourage participants to wash their hands, bring PPE, and bring their own equipment (water bottle, sunscreen, towels, etc.)
- Concessions will be sold as normal
- Pools will be limited to 50% of water capacity
 - o Outdoor Pool- 150 people
 - o Indoor Pool- 140 people
- Water fountains will not be available at this time at either facility
 - o Bottled water is available for purchase at both facilities

Indoor Pool Specific Guidelines

- Chairs will not be on the deck for use right now
- There will be designated showers appropriately spaced out for users
- Fitness equipment can still be used during lap swim
 - o We are encouraging people to bring their own equipment
 - o If swimmers borrow VCPR equipment from the Blue Storage Container, they will need to put it in the "Used Equipment" bin after use so it can be sanitized by staff at the end of shift
- Hot tub
 - o Normal hot tub rules will be enforced but there will be a limit of 50% capacity in the hot tub to 8 users (enforced by guards and signage)

Outdoor Pool Specific Guidelines

- Benches will be on the deck but spaced out
- Limited locker-room use
 - o Patrons will be encouraged to not to leave any personal belongings in the locker-room
 - o There will be no shower use at this time.
- Large slide will have designated spots for users to wait to encourage social distancing
- Small play feature will be closed until further notice
 - o Fountains and sprinkles will remain on
- Yellow tape
 - o Where there is yellow tape, patrons need to stay on the yellow tape to social distance- located at the front door and on the slide
